April 17th the Group met at the Washington State Patrol Fire Training Center out of North Bend to complete a site survey.

Guests that attended were Jason Daniels and Don Crawford from the City of Edmonds; as well as Mike Bevin, Dan Loch and Brian Stoss from the City of Issaguah.

The Group met up at the Fire Training Center at 9AM on April 17th. The sun was out and it turned into a beautiful day. We first met in a small training room to discuss the make-up of the facility. They are supplied with potable water from their own private well. That water comes from the well across the campus and into the treatment building. The water is treated by means of hypo chlorite injection and is then piped out through the potable system.

The fresh water is delivered to the waste water treatment plant, the dorm rooms, the training rooms and a variety of out buildings.

The firefighting water is a separate system for fire suppression in the appropriate buildings and supplies the hydrants in the training areas. After use at the hydrants, it drains into holding ponds and is pumped back and re used.

The Group surveyed the buildings that utilize fresh water. Bob Eastwood, Dale Baxmann and Tim Cantwell, a few of the more seasoned veterans, chased pipes and determined if they thought adequate backflow assemblies were in place. They shared their thoughts and explained what they saw to the less experienced CCS's. There were a few unanswered questions regarding the piping that was not visible, but overall, things looked good. The Group will offer a letter with recommendations to improve conditions such as labeling pipes and identifying the "unknowns".

Everyone enjoyed and gained some knowledge on how to conduct a survey. There is just nothing better than the hands-on approach to really understand where to start in a complex plumbing facility, such as their sewage treatment plant. Thanks to everyone who participated to make the training and the site survey a great success. We would also like to thank Levi for the time he spent showing us around. I've attached some fun photos from the day. You will need to manually move through the slide show. The power point I built was just too big to email.

The next meeting will be held at the South Seattle Community College on May 15th at 10:00 AM. Chip Brooks from the Local 699 Sprinklerfitters Union, and Group member, will be hosting a presentation on fire suppression systems.
