In Tony's absence, Vice Chair Chris Sutton called the meeting to order at 10:10 AM. Treasurer Dennis reported that we have \$18,787.12 in the account.

The first discussion was directed around the organization of the BAT Forum in March. Bob and some others are presently working on the agenda. Chris has agreed to MC the event and will start off with a few short presentations from the State CCC reps and Washington Certification Services. We are still working on the details. Dale Baxmann will be available to answer questions regarding BAT certification testing. King County Plumbing Inspectors will be available for fielding questions. We will be in the presences of a great variety of BAT professionals as well as many CCS representatives from Cities and other water purveyors. As always, the BAT Forum is an excellent opportunity for communication on all levels of expertise. It is an opportunity to meet colleagues, ask questions and seek better ways of enhancing our companies and daily jobs by implementing best practices and sharing experiences.

It will be held at La Quinta Suites in Tacoma on March 18<sup>th</sup> at 9 AM. Please bring your questions and answers to share!!

We voted to purchase of a projector for the meeting as well as some flip charts and various other needs to enhance the presentation. Chris will make the purchase and bring another laptop to use. We often need this equipment and usually becomes a last minute scramble to come up with it, so we all feel that if we can purchase it for \$600.00 or less, we should invest.

The topic of the day was irrigation systems, testing and maintenance. The Group welcomes Darin Graves from HD Fowler to share his extensive knowledge. There was a discussion on when and where to install blow outs and why they are sometimes incorrectly placed or left out entirely. Darin spoke of the dangers of using compressors that have the ability to run a jackhammer, and recommended using line pressure only for winterization. With that being said, Tim was wondering if using a compressor could create a high hazard cross connection and wondered if a double-check was adequate for the hazard presented. A thought to ponder......and maybe someone at the Forum will address that concern.

Fred from Backflows Only gave his insight as to how to winterize a DCVA in a box. He suggested bubble wrap or other material for keeping the assembly from freezing. He further said that you could find an old couch cushion alongside the road and BAM, you have your insulation! I don't mean to poke fun at him. Fred was very knowledgeable and extremely humorous. We enjoyed having him at the meeting along with his son, Jacob. Fred has some good information to share and is planning to speak a bit at the Forum, so be looking for him!

Fred commented that purveyors should be able to make exceptions on the placement of backflow assemblies to alleviate the chances for flooding of the boxes.

Tim prompted the discussion of drip systems and faucet supplied irrigation. We discussed the potential hazards crested with frost free yard hydrants as well as other creative ways folks come up with to water.

The meeting adjourned at noon.
